Workers that have been terminated, laid off, had a reduction of hours or are self-employed and unable to work due to COVID-19 are eligible for up to \$800 in supportive services.

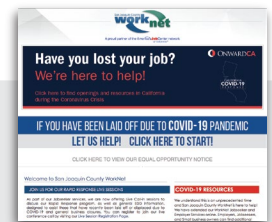
Supportive Services awards can be used for

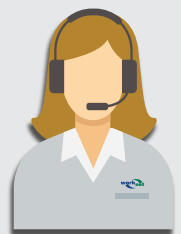
